# PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The season of 2021-2022 mirrored that of the previous season in that the start of the season was again delayed by six weeks due to the impact of COVID-19.

Despite this delay, the club enjoyed one of its most successful in many years.

Season highlights included;

- Further growth of our junior program – we now field eight junior teams, a 300% increase from five years prior
- First the first time in our 166 year history, we fielded a Junior Girls team
- We created the foundation to enter a senior Women's Team for the 2022-2023 season
- We added a senior X1 this season, a father and son type of set up which proved a resounding success
- All Men's Senior teams played finals
- The Club enhanced its already strong financial position, recording another healthy operating profit in the face of a shortened season and COVID-19 limitations.

On the field, I would like to thank and congratulate Justin Witcher, Christian Kostakis, Andrew Stone and Shaun Pratt for their remarkable season's getting all their X1's into the finals.

To Justin and the First X1, commiserations on the Grand Final loss. As everyone is aware, we set high expectations for all our playing X1's, none higher than the First X1 in whom the Club expects to win a premiership each season it competes.

We left one of the table last year and need to redeem ourselves in 2022-2023.

In addition to the above, I would like to make mention that the club finished third in the **DVCA Spirit of Cricket Award** which is voted on by the umpires in a variety of categories. I consider this award very highly and like a flag, I expect us to win this award each year. It is reflective of how our First X1 respect the opposition and umpires and how we go about the game.

A win in that next year too is part of the plan.

The Second X1, led by Christian (when not playing First X1) proved a formidable opponent in B-Grade of the DVCA. This team spent the majority of the year in the top four and unfortunately bowed out in the Semi-Final. Well done Cookie and crew on another great year.

What a dream come true for the 3rd X1. These boys enjoyed a great first half of the season, then dropped a few games to find themselves out of the four as we approached the finals. With some good fortune the Thirds fell into the four after the last round.

They then proceeded to win THREE remarkable finals games including the Grand Final to record the clubs only 2021-2022 senior **PREMIERSHIP**. WELL DONE STONEY and all the players in the Third's throughout the season.

Congratulations to Gavin Watson on winning this grade level's batting average with an incredible 573 runs @ 81.86.

To Shaun Pratt and Brad Grindal, enormous thanks for getting the Fourth X1 off the ground. It was extremely important to reinstate a fourth senior X1 and absolute proof that if you plan and believe something can happen it invariably does. This team proved to be a resounding success with many ex and some new senior players, playing competitive senior cricket with their sons. The team finished second on the ladder at the end of the home and away season but unfortunately lost their two finals in tough games. Well done to all players on a fantastic season.

We continue to operate on the basis that apart from those in coaching roles, we don’t pay players to play for Heidelberg Cricket Club.

With almost every other club doing the opposite and some paying exorbitant sums of money for poor to average players to play park cricket, the club takes the view that it’s far more beneficial and equal upon everyone from players and importantly volunteers that we invest in multiple other avenues that provide value to players.

This can include everything from the facilities we provide, to discounted membership and gear, to employment opportunities. There’s multiple other ways of rewarding players without paying cash.

Culture is the difference between Clubs and we take great pride in providing a culture that is fundamentally the reason people play cricket with us.

Since season 1998-1999, under this operating model, our First X1 has completed in no less than 15 Grand Finals. I think the model works.

So that's a wrap on another successful season, albeit one that didn't deliver the ultimate prize but does give is a key target for next year.

In closing, I would like to acknowledge the passing of former Junior Coach and Fourth X1 Captain Ian Walker. Ian was a fantastic asset for the club in the late 80's and 90's coaching and mentoring a generation of HCC players, many of whom remain attached to club today.

Lastly, thanks to my family for their ongoing support in my role.

I cannot wait for a new FULL season to begin.
