PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Welcome to the 166th Annual report of the Heidelberg Cricket Club. After what amounted to consecutive seasons of delayed starts due to the global pandemic that was COVID-19, anticipation was high for a full and successful season.

After getting the season underway and beautiful conditions and with an away win, hope quickly turned to despair after Melbourne's highly seasonal spring weather showed its best form dousing the area in massive rainfall.

Such was the extent of the rain, it caused Warringal Park to flood for the first time since February 2005. That first inundation was followed by a second just 10 days later. Not only did the entire oval area flood twice but the newly refurbished change rooms went under twice in the same period destroying all the refurbished works.

Unlike the summer of 2005, different emergency management protocols applied and Banyule Council stepped in to manage the situation. That action meant the change rooms were unusable in the short term until the damage was assessed and then subsequently were off limits for the entire season as restoration works were carried out.

The floods were the culmination of three very disrupted years, the first with the upgrade of the change room facilities rendering them out of bounds during construction works, then second being the floods and the third in season 2023/2024 will again see us displaced for three seasons out of the last four due to Warringal Park resurfacing.

I must commend all members and especially the players for the resilience shown without complaint in dealing with these dreadful disruptions and focussing on the issues that really matter.

Off the field the club reported a slight operating loss in 2022/23 a significant achievement given what we endured during the course of the season due to the weather and subsequent disruptions.

Whilst our First XI missed the finals for just the second time in six years, our lower XI's all featured in the March action with our Third XI emerging as Premiers in the F2 grade. An awesome achievement guys and great credit to Pratty, Stoney and Gavin Watson in particular who have managed those lower XI's so well over recent years.

Special thanks and congratulations to Ash Riley on the highly successful introduction of Women's Cricket to the club.

How incredible it was to see the black and yellow out there that first Sunday in October and then continue on the play off in the Grand Final of the Spring Season, our very first season.

We didn't get the chocolates that first Grand Final but so determined were the women to make amends they reversed the disappointment of the Spring to take out the Summer competition in a thrilling game against Greensborough. Well done to everyone involved especially Ash, Dos for his fantastic commitment to assisting the girls every Sunday and to Phil for scoring.

To Pratty and the juniors awesome to have as many sides up and playing full credit to you for your efforts.

I'll leave all the details to the various reports throughout this publication but I would like to note a special contribution from Roger Golland who assumed the role of grants Manager and did an extraordinary job securing much needed funds for the club.

Special thanks to **Banyule Council** for their assistance in granting funding for the 2022 This Girl Can Program which led to funds being directly injected into our entire female cricket program. We were fortunate to also receive additional grants from **Banyule Council** for Equipment (used to enable e-scoring in all senior grades and women's matches) and also a Community Grant for Training and Development. We thank the **Banyule Council** and its Officer's enormously.

Other grants included those from the **Victorian State Government**, **Cricket Australia** and a significant contribution from the Australian Community Infrastructure Fund (via CA and CV) for an upgrade to our scoreboard at Warringal Park.

The culmination of the season saw a review of our on-season leadership and the departure of Justin Whitcher who has returned to his previous club, Lower Eltham.

The club enjoyed incredible success under the direction of Justin playing in four out of six Grand Finals during his tenure.

We thank Justin enormously for his contribution to HCC and he will always be viewed as a legend of the club.

In closing, my usual thanks to all those on the committee for their contributions to Club Operations. We can't exist without your valuable time you commit to the club.

Special thanks to John Gilham who steps down as Treasurer of the club after eight or so years. Not only an enormous volunteer of the club but also a major sponsor. Thanks enormously John for all your work and generosity.

Lastly thank you to Clare and my family who continue to support me with my at times unhealthy but mostly healthy obsession.

JUNIOR CO-ORDINATOR'S REPORT

The 2022-2023 season kicked off with a challenging start due to floods and limited ground availability. In the face of these obstacles and with most Indoor Cricket centres fully booked, the preparation for the 22-23 season proved to be a daunting task for both the kids and coaches. Nevertheless, I want to extend full credit to the dedicated coaches and team managers who displayed remarkable determination in making our season possible whenever the opportunity arose.

This season marked a remarkable growth in our Junior Club, driven by an increasing number of Junior Girls & Boys keen to play Cricket. We expanded our Junior Club to include 10 Junior Teams, a substantial increase from the 7 teams of the previous year. This was undoubtedly the highest number of Junior Sides the Club has ever fielded in a single season. The teams comprised 2 x Under 10s, 2 x Level 1 Girls Teams, 1 x Under 12s, 2 x Under 14s, 2 x Under 16s, and 1 x Under 18s.

Stepping into the role of Junior Coordinator was a task I hadn't anticipated, yet with the incredible support I received from my peers and the wisdom shared by experienced individuals throughout the year, my transition into this role was notably smoother. However, the most rewarding aspect was witnessing the kids taking to the field, enjoying the game of cricket alongside their friends and families. Our Junior Club thrives on the involvement of parents, coaches, and team managers, collectively fostering a strong sense of community that defines our club. (A special acknowledgment to Cooky for his substantial efforts in shaping the junior program over the past years.)

Throughout this season, we experienced a mix of triumphs and challenges. Among the 7 teams engaged in full competitive cricket, 4 teams managed to secure a place in the finals, and 3 of those advanced to the Grand Finals. While it was disheartening to witness Under 14 White, Under 14 Teal, Under 16 Teal, and Under 18 Teal falling short in the Grand Finals and Semi-Finals, the journey was a testament to the players' dedication and hard work.

Another heartening aspect was the significant number of junior players who stepped up to play in Senior matches, ranging from 4th Grade to 1st Grade. Their achievements stand as a true testament to their abilities and commitment. Looking ahead, we are optimistic about the future, expecting to witness a surge of girls progressing into Senior Women's Cricket.

I extend my heartfelt gratitude to our dedicated coaches who made this season possible: Jason Lewis and Toby Simpson for Level 1 Girls, Emma Revira and Paul Moon for Under 10s Boys, Dave Reid Under 12s, Mark Doyle & Damien Gattuso/Andrew Fotinopoulos for Under 14s, Andrew Stone for Under 16s, and Greg Thomas for Under 18s. A massive thank you also goes to the tireless team managers and parents who lent their support throughout the year, ensuring that our young players could take the field each week.

I'd like to offer special congratulations to the following Junior players: Abbey Lewis and Ava Shiva for their selection and participation in the Rep Girls Side this Season, Hudson Ramsay and Henry Stone for their inclusion in the Boys Rep Side, and Will Sinnett for his selection in the 1st XI Side. A round of applause to all of you.

In my role as Junior Coordinator, I express my gratitude to Justin Whitcher and Brad Mitchell for their unwavering support, aiding in training and guiding the juniors. A sincere thank you to all the senior players who took time out of their Friday and Wednesday nights to watch the juniors play; your presence undeniably spurred our young talents to greater heights.
