Juniors.

I cannot thank John Hand enough for his contribution to the club and his performance as junior manager. He is well organised and totally understands the importance of communication.

To finish the season with all junior sides in the semi finals was a remarkable achievement. Credit and congratulations to all coaches, Stuey Nihill, Russell Kelly, John Hand, Graeme Crispe, Steve Cashen and Dave Mattasoni.

The icing on the cake was John Hand's superstars – the U/14 Gold. Worthy premiers.

Off field.

We have some worries. I worry deeply about a club culture whereby members expect everything to be done for them. We are not a professional club. The club is run by people who volunteer their time for the benefit of everyone.

Here's an example. In 2005/2006, Bluey ran the bar. We had NO outgoings in relation to bar management which led to an increase in profits. In 2006/2007 I effectively ran the bar, ordered, paid the bills, did the banking. As I was playing we needed to employ someone to be there Saturday afternoons. That is where Rita came in. Nobody was willing to work behind the bar after they played so Rita stayed on a little longer. The end result – approx \$1,800 of outgoings, straight off the bottom line.

Last year, once again nobody was prepared to be responsible for the bar so we had to employ someone from outside the club to do that job for us. End result with Rita and Mark near on \$6,000 worth of outgoings, straight off the bottom line.

I am not suggesting that we don't necessarily remunerate people for doing work for the club. Rita of course is a must to stay. What concerns me is an apathetic approach whereby we completely lose contact with what a club is about and we revert to a system where we outsource just about every task that is required to operate the club.

That to me is the opposite of what a local community based club is all about.

If the club heads down that path, well, for sure you won't see me in any official role and you can expect annual membership fees to increase five-fold.

I urge everyone to think about the role the club plays in your life and not what you expect from the club but what can you contribute.

I thank those blokes who were on the committee this year and who filled in their time on a roster for the bar. The workload has and will not diminish.

I thank the Football Club for a positive and rewarding partnership at Warringal. We are very fortunate that we are administrations that think similarly and have values that are built on historic success.

Lastly I am getting tired. My commitments to the family, kids and my business have escalated significantly over the past two years. There is no possible way I can maintain my same level of commitment as has been the case of previous years.

I happy to remain as President if the club wants me but this year I will not be tied to the club.

I have said it every year for past 18 and I'll say it once more. Thanks to Clare, Emma, Hayley and Lachlan for allowing me to fulfil what is fast becoming a lifetime passion for the Heidelberg Cricket Club.

Second Grade Captain's Report



With the demise of the fifth grade competition, the clubs fourth XI was entered in to the Fourth grade. It was a step up from the previous years, but one which we were confident the team would be to manage. The grade consisted of ten teams, a few being the 2nd or 3rd XI's of other clubs, but the given the depth of the club, especially of some the talented juniors the club has in its ranks, the feeling was that we would be able to challenge for a finals berth again. Whilst the team ended the season a few wins away from our goal, we weren't far off the pace and had some good wins through the season, with some great team efforts and some sparkling individual performances. We finished the season in seventh position, but with a little more luck and a tad more consistency we would have played finals again.

Being the last team to fill on the roster meant that the line up from week to week could change dramatically, and that we had to call on some of the clubs talented juniors to fill the team. By seasons end the team had used a total of 37 players, with at least 13 juniors. Although not having a settled side meant that occasionally the produced some poor results, a couple of outright losses for the season, the team still managed to win one outright, three wins on the first innings, and due to some dodgy umpiring, a tie. The outright win against West Ivanhoe was set up with an excellent batting effort from the team, ending our innings with a score of 468, even though we didn't manage to bat the overs out. Another excellent team batting effort in the game against Edinburgh saw us chase down 282 with 9 overs to spare. Conversely, it was a disappointment when we were unable to defend 357 against Greensborough.

There were many individual highlights for the season. Top run scorer was Calvin Plowright, with 337 runs from six matches, including 1 century and two 50's. Mark Favrin had the highest individual innings of 201, and Sam Byrne produced my favourite for the season, an unbeaten 103 to get us over the line against Edinburgh. Sam also knocked up a half century through the season. Russell Kelly, John Clarke, and Alex Domini, also hit 50's. Honourable mentions go to Sachin Anand, Brad Nihill, Stuart Nihill, Sam English, and Paul Williams for some nice 30' & 40's

Calvin Plowright also ended the season with the most wickets, 14 at 19 runs, with two great efforts, 5/41 and 4/14, but two lads who really stepped up this year were Sachin Anand, 12 wickets at 20 runs, and Sam Byrne, 11 wickets at 16.5. They made it easy for a captain to throw them the ball with confidence, as they made it hard for the opposition to score and produced some great wicket taking balls. Also, playing for the first time in the seniors, Nic Biscontin produced some fine spells for his 6 wickets, and Stephen Edwards from the U-14s continued the family tradition by producing 5 wickets from 4 matches. When we could persuade Phil Edwards to don the whites he didn't disappoint, snaring 8 wickets at 18.

All in all, there was enough in the season to give us hope that we will come back next year and fight hard for a spot in the top four. Also, as my first season as captain, I have to say that it has been an immensely enjoyable experience, not withstanding some nerves early in the season. I was extremely proud of the efforts put in by the lads, and am sure that as well as trying hard to win our games, we played them in the right spirit IDELBERG and had many laughs out on the field. Looking forward to next season.

Appendix I

Batting - Minimum of 5 innings and 150 runs. Otherwise most runs

Bowling - Minimum of 5 innings and 180 balls. Otherwise most wickets.

U/12 Qualification Requirements -:

Batting - Minimum of 5 innings and 100 runs. Otherwise most runs

Bowling - Minimum of 5 innings and 120 balls. Otherwise most wickets.

Team Notations

In season 2007-08 the Heidelberg Cricket Club, in its 151st year, fielded four senior teams and seven junior teams. The club also hosted a MILO program for approximately 40 kids aged 5-9 years old.

In the seniors, the club's 1^{st} XI, 2^{nd} XI, 3^{rd} XI and 4^{th} XI participated in the HDCA's First, Second, Third and Fourth Grades respectively.

In the juniors, as a general guide, the club's first year players in their age-group participated in the HDCA's Green competition, whilst second year players competed in the Gold competition. For the U/12 team, we elected to participate in the HDCA's Gold competition because it offered 2-day matches. The U/12 Kookaburra's is for young players, generally under 10 years of age. No match results are recorded for the Kookaburras.

Additionally, the club once again conducted a 'Milo Cricket' program throughout the season. This 12 week program teaches children (aged 4 through 9) the skills of the game through various training drills and doesn't involve a fixtured competition. In 2007-08, some 40 children participated in the HCC's Milo Cricket-Have-A-Go program which was managed by Craig Stevens and Craig Ladd.
