Second Grade Captain's Report

Season 2009-10 was never going to be an easy season in Second Grade with the retirement of key players from last season's premiership side and the consistent unavailability of players from the higher grades in the early part of the season. Players need to realise that their absence in the early part of the season has a big impact on where our sides finish at the end of the season. In our case, we missed the finals by a game and had beaten all the top 4 sides other than the eventual premiers, West Ivanhoe. Possibly a missed opportunity to win back to back flags.

The changing of the guard however allowed the club to fast track some of our talented junior players up into second grade a season or so before they might have had the opportunity. This was certainly the case when we arrived at Rosanna's ground for a Sunday one day game with one of the youngest and inexperienced second sides I have played in. The young guys, some playing their first game at this level stood up to the challenge and we had a memorable win with a six off the last ball sealing the game.

The young players we blooded in the first half of the season included Matt Broughan, Len Lambroglou, Sam Byrne, Jack Ridewood, Dan Kelly, Marcus Macloed, Ben Colliver, Chris Millson and Pat Millson. We also had some of our more seasoned young players such as Andy Edwards, Tom Keating, Brad Nihill, Nic Bisconton, Smouty, Kishy and Gavin Watson also playing with us. All these players showed they have the talent to be good players for the club and to continue to push for First Grade selection over the next 10 years.

Brian and Jack Ridewood came to the club from Rosanna and were a father/son combination for a few games during the year. It was a highlight for the season that their performances enabled them to play together in First Grade, a great effort that is rarely achieved.

The first half of the season saw us lose 5 of the first 6 games however with the improvement of the younger players and the injection of some senior players we went on a 5 game winning streak that put us in contention for a finals birth. It is no coincidence that Steve Cashen played in 3 of these wins. Who will forget his great 100 in a one day game against Bellfield, where he batted for less than 20 overs. The young (and older) players in the team learn a heap from playing with Cash and watching how he goes about his business, particularly the way he values his wicket. Thanks for your help Cash.

We needed to beat Rosanna in the last game to make the finals however we were not able to repeat our effort from early in the season and were left to ponder what might have been.

I would like to thank some of the old timers in the side who supported me during the year and assisted with captaining the side. Matty Earl, Robbo (who made himself available when it looked like we might make the finals), Banger, Riders and Raj all did a great job over the year passing on their experience to the younger players and contributing to an enjoyable team environment.

Thanks to the Committee for your tireless work in ensuring we can put teams on the field each week, In particular, we need to acknowledge the great job our President, Dean Turner does in ensuring that the Heidelberg Cricket Club remains a powerhouse in local cricket.

Congratulations to Brian Ridewood for winning the batting average and Kishy for winning the bowling average.

It was an enjoyable year and I look forward to seeing the benefits that will flow through to the club over the next few years as a result of all the young players who were given an opportunity to play in the higher grades this year.

To win a flag at junior level is something all the boys will remember forever.

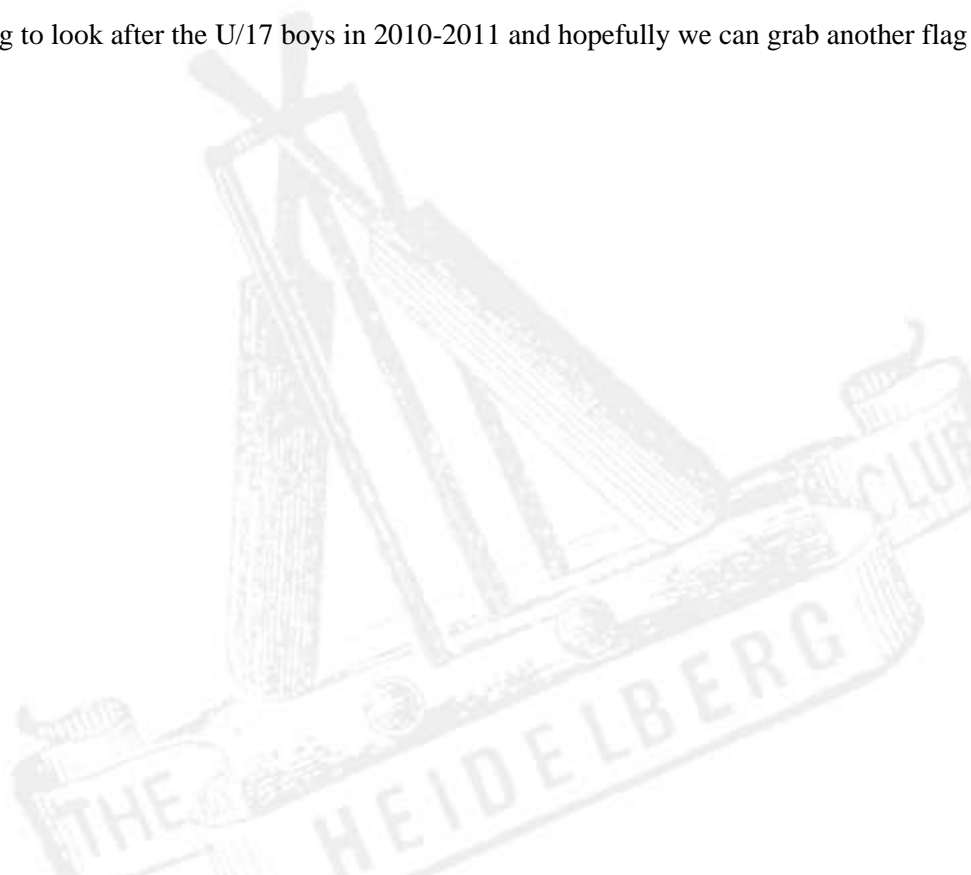

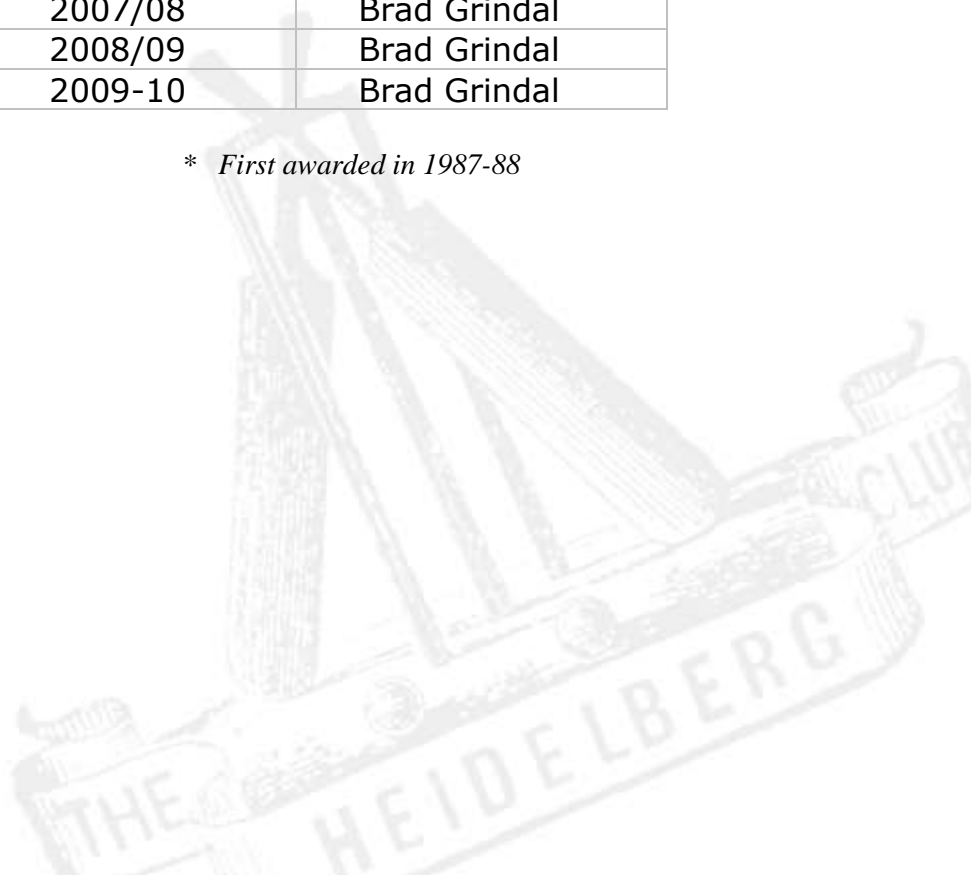

Batting - Minimum of 5 innings and 100 runs. Otherwise most runs
Bowling - Minimum of 5 innings and 120 balls. Otherwise most wickets.

Team Notations

In season 2009-09 the Heidelberg Cricket Club, in its 153rd year, fielded 4 senior teams and 8 junior teams. The club also hosted a MILO program for approximately 30 kids aged 5-9 years old.

In the seniors, the club's 1st XI, 2nd XI, 3rd XI and 4th XI participated in the HDCA's First, Second, Third and Fourth Grades respectively.

In the juniors, as a general guide, the club's first year players in their age-group participated in the HDCA's Green competition, whilst second year players competed in the Gold competition. For the U/13 team, we elected to participate in the HDCA's Gold competition because it offered 2-day matches. The Kookaburra's is for young players, generally under 10 years of age. No match results are recorded for the Kookaburras.

Additionally, the club once again conducted a 'Milo Cricket' program throughout the season. This 9 week program teaches children (aged 4 through 9) the skills of the game through various training drills and doesn't involve a fixtured competition. In 2009-10, some 30 children participated in the HCC's Milo Cricket-Have-A-Go program which was managed by Renato Dintinosante.
