TREASURER'S REPORT

I have pleasure in presenting the 2010/2011 financial report of the Heidelberg Cricket Club.

Details are in the attached Profit & Loss Statement, however some of the more significant items to report include;

- A net operating loss of \$4,114 LOSS for the FY ending 30 June 2011
- Income down \$13,973 on the previous year
- Bar revenue down \$6,164 on the previous year
- Sponsorship down \$3,100 on the previous year
- Utility costs up nearly \$1000 on previous year
- Subsidised match day umpires fees up nearly \$700 on previous year
- Loan repayments for nets up \$5000 on previous year.

So what needs to happen?

We simply must increase our income and focus on various revenue streams.

Membership must be seriously looked at as I believe it is way to low 1) compared to the fees charged by other local cricket clubs 2) for the facilities we are able to provide [and consequently pay more to the council for] and 3) the actual operational costs of the club are increasing and the club cannot continue to absorb these.

We have a great club, a great social facility, a great ground, great training facilities and soon to be great new change rooms and somewhere along the line members of the club need to pay their way for the use of these facilities.

Second Grade Captain's Report

After a disappointing year with the bat I will be standing down as a skipper of the thirds this year. I think it's time for someone younger to take on the role anyway and leave us old fossils to do a few other things around the club.

Trophy Winner Eligibility

Bowling - Minimum of 5 innings and 180 balls. Otherwise most wickets.

U/13 Qualification Requirements -:

Batting - Minimum of 5 innings and 100 runs. Otherwise most runs

Bowling - Minimum of 5 innings and 120 balls. Otherwise most wickets.

Team Notations

In season 2010-11 the Heidelberg Cricket Club, in its 154th year, fielded 4 senior teams and 7 junior teams. The club also hosted a MILO program for approximately 30 kids aged 5-9 years old.

In the seniors, the club's 1^{st} XI, 2^{nd} XI, 3^{rd} XI and 4^{th} XI participated in the HDCA's First, Second, Third and Fourth Grades respectively.

In the juniors, as a general guide, the club's first year players in their age-group participated in the HDCA's Green competition, whilst second year players competed in the Gold competition. The Kookaburra's is for young players, generally under 10 years of age. No match results are recorded for the Kookaburras.

Additionally, the club once again conducted a 'Milo Cricket' program throughout the season. This 9 week program teaches children (aged 4 through 9) the skills of the game through various training drills and doesn't involve a fixtured competition. In 2010-11, some 30 children participated in the HCC's Milo Cricket-Have-A-Go program which was managed by Renato Dintinosante.
