PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The seconds bowed out in the semi and the Third X1 just missed.

It is a great regret that we had to withdraw our Fourth X1 three games into the season due to the lack of numbers.

Numbers in cricket clubs are getting harder and harder to maintain. You simply must have juniors coming through the ranks to help supplement the gaps in Lower X1's. With only three players progressing to the U/18's and a first year group of U/16's we felt the full effects of that gap.

Hopefully that will change after the stunning come from behind U/16 premiership. Well done to all the boys and coach Lewie Balcombe.

So to the season that was.

I must thank our new Captain Coach Justin Witcher for his leadership of the club. It is somewhat imposing coming into a brand new club where you know really nobody but Justin accepted the challenge full on and delivered with an outstanding individual season and was able to navigate the First X1 into our first DVCA finals series.

Justin showed great understanding and patience (where he had every reason not to) with players making themselves unavailable for a host of reasons.

Congratulations to our lower level captains – Dave Roberts and Jack Gilham who did a great job all year, again they suffered heavily through player unavailability and inconsistent commitment.

The administration remain very focussed on youth development and growing from within.

The usual thanks can be applied again. To John Gilham our treasurer another great job controlling all the movement of monies from the cricket club accounts.

Despite being a predominantly amateur club the weekly running costs remain a very difficult proposition. Electricity costs alone have doubled in the last four years and now see us paying out around \$1,300 a month for power.

Well done and thanks John.

Well done to Craig Stevens, our secretary handling the administration of the club and to the other key portfolio managers such as Gavin Watson and Russell Gardner.

Andrew Fotinopolous and Jack Ridewood did a fine job on the social side of things and Riders has already set quite a few things in motion for the upcoming season.

Two people who deserve a special mention are Bluey for his tireless work as manager of all things bar and canteen and also the cleaning of the social club and change rooms.

Thanks boys.

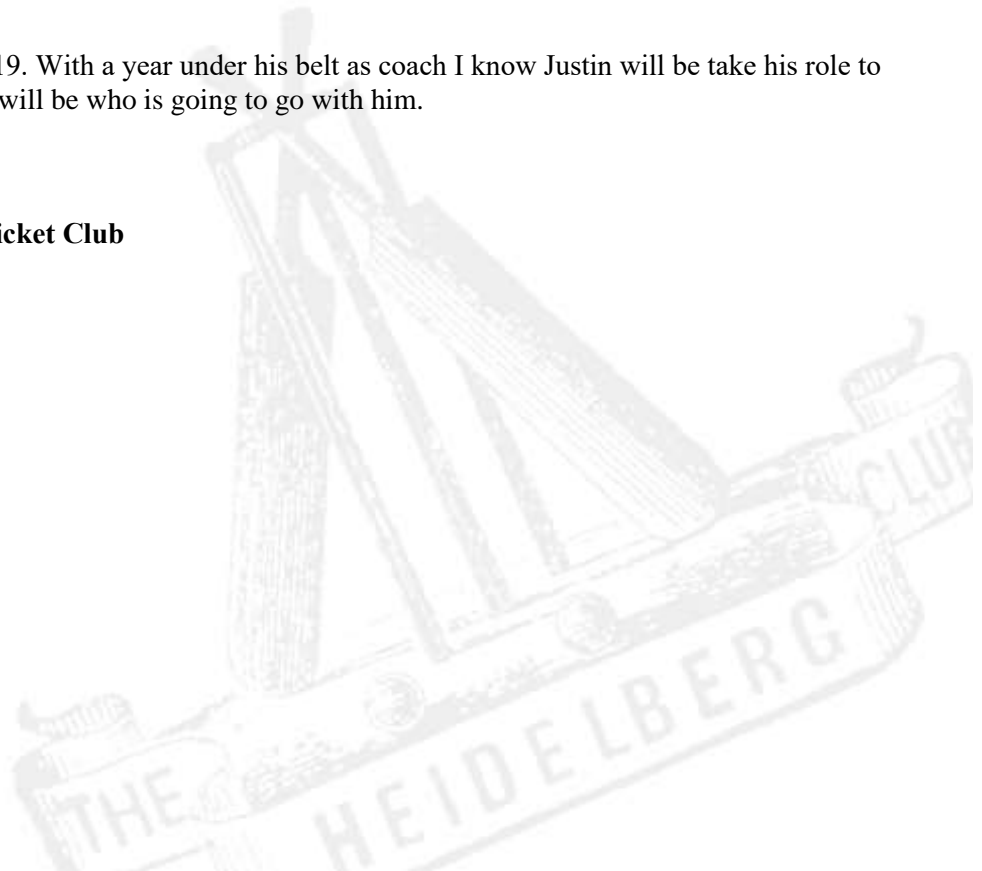

And overall had a successful season.

With the thirds needing to win the last round they narrowly lost. There were over 30 players used with great adversity but what that shows is we have the numbers if we can achieve a greater commitment this coming season.

The second eleven also exceeded expectation with regular changes caused by unavailability throughout. Losing a tight semi-final to play off they did themselves proud and unearthed some genuine future talent.

And finally A grade. We as a group of 17 for the year improved and learnt a lot by seasons end. We sat 4th at Xmas with some inconsistencies to that point. The wins were quality and the losses disappointing as this game requires input by all and roles played consistently.

JUNIOR MANAGER'S REPORT

Season 2017/18 overview:

- Two under 12s sides, one under 16s side and an under 18s combined side with Banyule CC.
- Greg Thomas coach of u12s Red A. Andrew Stone coach of u12s White A. Lewis Balcombe coach of under 16s Red. Michael Harte coach of u18s.

Under 12s Red A, Greg Thomas:

- Had an extremely competitive year despite having relatively low numbers. Numbers grew stronger as the season progressed which culminated in better on field results. Narrowly missed out on finals after losing the last game of the home and away season, finishing 5th. If numbers were as they had been in the last few rounds, finals would've been comfortably achieved. **Batting average:** James Thomas, avg. 77.25. **Bowling average:** James Thomas, avg. 7.27. Jacob Innocenzi also had a super year, averaging 51 with the bat, and 11.83 with the ball.

Under 12s White A, Andrew Stone:

- This side had a wonderful year. They were by far the best side in the grade, which is an exceptional effort considering the vast majority of players were bottom age. Finished the home and away season on top of the ladder. Unfortunately lost their semi-final, but the experience the kids will gain from that prepares them very well for forthcoming seasons. **Batting average:** Lucas Wilson, avg. 22.25. **Bowling average:** Henry Stone, avg. 3.22.

Under 16s Red, Lewis Balcombe:

- Quite clearly the story of the season. A new coach who was reluctant to take on the role, coaching what was effectively an under 14s and 16s combined side, with Lachie Biggs (captain) the only top age player. An up and down home and away season, with flashes of brilliance by Lachie Biggs who made a century, left them in a position where they just scraped into the top 4 to qualify for finals. They faced the seemingly unbeatable Bundoora at Yulong Reserve and were put in to bat. Oscar Brazzale assumed his usual opening post, with an inspired move by Balcombe to thrust Mac Ryan up the order. Oscar made 25, Mac top scored with 37. Biggs chipped in with 17, Hoyne a very handy 24, and Steve Hannah finishing with 11 no left them with a score of 139. The bowling performance was flawless. Macdara opened the attack beautifully, picking up 2 wickets, whilst Ted was miserly in his opening spell. Sam Hoyne finished the job with 1/11 off of his full quota, Steve Hannah a handy wicket also. The pick of the bowlers was captain Lachie Biggs, picking up 3/17 off of his full quota. Bundoora done for 115. Onto the grand-final.
- The GF was against a remarkably strong Diamond Creek, with a side full of top-age players on their home deck. We were to bat first. The opening pair that performed in the semi-final unfortunately failed on this occasion, and the start was disastrous. Then, captain Lachie Biggs strode to the crease and turned the game on its head due to a wonderful partnership with Ted Meehan. They put on 100 runs, Lachie with 61 and Ted with 39, taking us to a competitive total of 127. Again, a superb bowling performance occurred. Sam Hoyne and Mac Ryan opening, both starting very tightly. All bowlers did precisely what was required, Hoyne taking 3/28 and the winning wicket, Ryan 0/9, Meehan 1/22, Brazzale 1/19, Hannah 0/16, O'Grady 0/4, Biggs 2/23, and Campbell 0/9. We won in an extremely tight affair, with Biggs being named man of the match. Against every odds possible throughout the season, especially during finals, this will forever be remembered 'The Miracle at Marngrook'. A famous win that will remain in the minds of players, coaches and spectators for the rest of their lives. **Batting average:** Lachie Biggs, avg. 50. **Bowling average:** Macdara O'Grady, avg. 12.86.

JUNIOR MANAGER'S REPORT (CONT.)

Under 18s, Michael Harte:

- The combined u18s side were clearly the most talented in their age group. A star-studded line up with players such as Luke Sirianni, Alex Pannell, Ben Crick, Pat Turner, Nick Mayne and Connor Tolley. They cruised to 2nd after the home and away season and played an absolute thriller in the semi-final, unfortunately losing on the last ball of the match. Most certainly an opportunity gone begging as we see all too often with talented u18s sides, as ability isn't maximised. **Batting average:** Luke Sirianni, avg. 35. **Bowling average:** Alex Pannell, avg. 13.11.

Summary:

In summary, considering the transitional season that the junior club underwent, it could be deemed a success. Not merely from the perspective of results, where three out of four sides tasted finals, but from an enjoyment and foundation viewpoint, the kids and coaches thoroughly enjoyed it and built a fantastic base for the future. It was always going to be difficult given the complete overhaul and new roles on every post, but it left us with a great grounding. As a club, we deserved the ultimate success and got just that due to the sensational efforts of Lewis' u16s side, who created the unlikeliest piece of history. Onwards and upwards next season, with many additional changes that will only build on what was established in 2017/18.
