That is the exact reason there was growth of playing numbers in each age group, and what has created interest in our program by external clubs' families.

For all of these reasons, we should be excited by what the upcoming years will entail. It will continue to be a mentality of "more", because without that we'll fail to evolve and come up with alternatives and initiatives that make the Heidelberg Cricket Club such a desirable place to be in the summer. We're most definitely on
