However, based on feedback of parents and kids, that didn't matter as much due to a whole club buying into the juniors and making it obvious that they were a priority going forward. That is the exact reason there was growth of playing numbers in each age group, and what has created interest in our program by external clubs' families.

For all of these reasons, we should be excited by what the upcoming years will entail. It will continue to be a mentality of "more", because without that we'll fail to evolve and come up with alternatives and initiatives that make the Heidelberg Cricket Club such a desirable place to be in the summer. We're most definitely on

Appendix I

Trophy Winner Eligibility

Player must be a fully financial member of the Heidelberg Cricket Club.

First Grade Qualification Requirements -:

Batting - Minimum of 7 innings and 200 runs. Otherwise most runs. Bowling - Minimum of 500 balls. Otherwise most wickets.

All Other Senior Grades Qualification Requirements -:

Batting - Minimum of 5 innings and 200 runs. Otherwise most runs. Bowling - Minimum of 300 balls. Otherwise most wickets.

U/18, U/16 & U/14 Qualification Requirements -:

Batting - Minimum of 5 innings and 150 runs. Otherwise most runs Bowling - Minimum of 180 balls. Otherwise most wickets.

U/12 Qualification Requirements -:

Batting - Minimum of 5 innings and 100 runs. Otherwise most runs Bowling - Minimum of 120 balls. Otherwise most wickets.
