# PRESIDENT'S REPORT

What a year!

We entered 2019/2020 with a great deal of excitement but also a degree of trepidation. Finally, after a seven year holding pattern, we returned to the top division in the competition we play in after moving from the HDCA in 2012/2013.

To finish second on the ladder at the conclusion of the home and away season was a stunning result and full credit and thanks to Justin Witcher for leading a predominately home grown group of players throughout the season and furthering their development to enable us to contend finals.

The semi-final was incredible, one of the great wins ever witnessed at Warringal and enabling us to venture to Plenty Park to contend the Grand Final against a great club and opposition in Diamond Creek.

To post a very, very competitive 204 with the best bowling attack in the comp to defend that total, hopes were high we would secure victory in our very first Barclay Shield final and become the first club to achieve Money Shield and Barclay Shield Premierships in consecutive years.

Over that first weekend, it was becoming apparent that the COVID-19 global pandemic was impacting society in a way never seen before in our lifetimes.

There was debate as to whether the game would continue at all the following Saturday and it was not until 2pm the Friday before that local councils forbade the use of their ovals and all Grand Finals were cancelled.

It was a bitter blow for the club as there was a genuine feeling of confidence that we could defend that total but sadly we will never know.

The consolation was a declaration of joint premiers, a bitter pill to swallow at the time, but with the benefit of hindsight came the realisation that it was recognition for an outstanding season by the club.

Our second X1 also enjoyed an outstanding season contending finals in our first season in B-Grade, a remarkable achievement and testament to Gavin Watson and his group of players who played in our Second X1 throughout the season. Well done Gav.

Stoney again had the task of looking after our Third X1 and did a superb job despite a slow start. Things got rolling late in the season with some great wins and incredibly close losses. In many ways it's a challenging X1 to look after with a mix of players often new to the seniors and even new to the club and things take a little time to click. Well done Stoney.

The Heidelberg CC Vets got back up and going last year thanks to Craig Hunter. It was a huge success with over 15 past players testing the hamstrings and calves throughout the year. Well done Hunts we look forward to going again bigger and better than last year.

To Christian Kostakis, thanks for once again looking after the junior component of the club. This is a crucial part of the club's activity for without juniors we really have no sustainable club model. We will continue to provide the best coaching and management we can, careful not to grow for the sake of being the biggest, preferring to focus on managing the development of players from boys to adult men in their playing skills and more importantly growth as people.

Well done Cooky and all the junior managers.

Congratulations to all individual trophy winners on your seasons. Individual reward is fantastic recognition for your contribution to the team's and club's success.

## PRESIDENT'S REPORT (CONT)

Off field we enjoyed another superb season. Once again the club pulled together to support the Pat Cronin Foundation Walk to the Valley in November raising over \$2,000 for the cause. We again called on club members to support victims of the horrendous bushfires in December and January. Brad Grindal, David Roberts and Jack Ridewood pulled together a past players T-20 match fundraising day and Lachlan Turner and Arton Cabdi contributed with their 'Shave for the Brave' idea.

Together both initiatives raised over \$10,000 for bushfire relief, a portion of the funds raised also going to an East Gippsland Wildlife Centre.

Jack Ridewood again did an incredible job in the role of Business Manager looking after all sorts of things from merchandise, to social functions, to sponsors, he is across all aspects of the club off the field. Great job Jack and enormous thanks for your effort. It's proof that the good guys get rewarded for their efforts with Jack finishing second in the Ray Christensen Medal for the best player in Barclay Shield.

I thank our Executive enormously – John Gilham, David Roberts and Craig Stevens for their work, counsel and guidance during the year.

John does an incredible job as Treasurer with the club turning over some \$157,000 to record an operating profit for the year of \$19,000. A super result. The club has very healthy cash reserves with liabilities of just \$6,000 being the balance remaining for our contribution to the new changerooms constructed 8 years ago. I would particularly like to thank David Roberts for his commitment, diligence and detail to get player memberships back on track across the board resulting in the collection of an additional \$12,000 in revenue or a 157% increase year on year.

We remain under pressure from occupancy costs now upwards of \$16,000 before we even bowl a ball and these will continue to rise each year.

Thanks to all our very generous sponsors. To put it simply, local community clubs just cannot function without support from business large and small and your assistance is never taken for granted.

Thanks to the Thursday night food boys for doing meals ever week for the players, members and supporters. A small but critical aspect of club operations but enormous in terms of maintaining our club culture.

My enthusiasm for the job of President of this great club hasn't waned at all and the incredible support of a great committee has only served to heighten that enthusiasm.

Again, I thank Clare, Emma and Hayley their support of me and the club. It's a joy to be involved with Lachlan and friends and in a small way to share another A-Grade flag with Lachlan was unbelievable.

We play the game for lots of reasons, namely community connection, enjoyment of one another's company and ultimately to test ourselves in the heat of battle in the quest to be declared the best in the relevant grades we play.

The season ahead we will be different. We are out to defend a joint premiership and clubs will be far better prepared when they come up against us. It will also be different in the sense we don't yet know what shape the season will take living with a pandemic in the community. Only time will tell.

What this year, post the grand has taught me, is the value of community sport and the role it plays in people's lives, particularly young people. When we do get back up and going we need to support one another and have a full appreciation of what we do, which, is not just about winning flags.

## Trophy Winner Eligibility

Batting - Minimum of 5 innings and 100 runs. Otherwise most runs

Bowling - Minimum of 120 balls. Otherwise most wickets.
