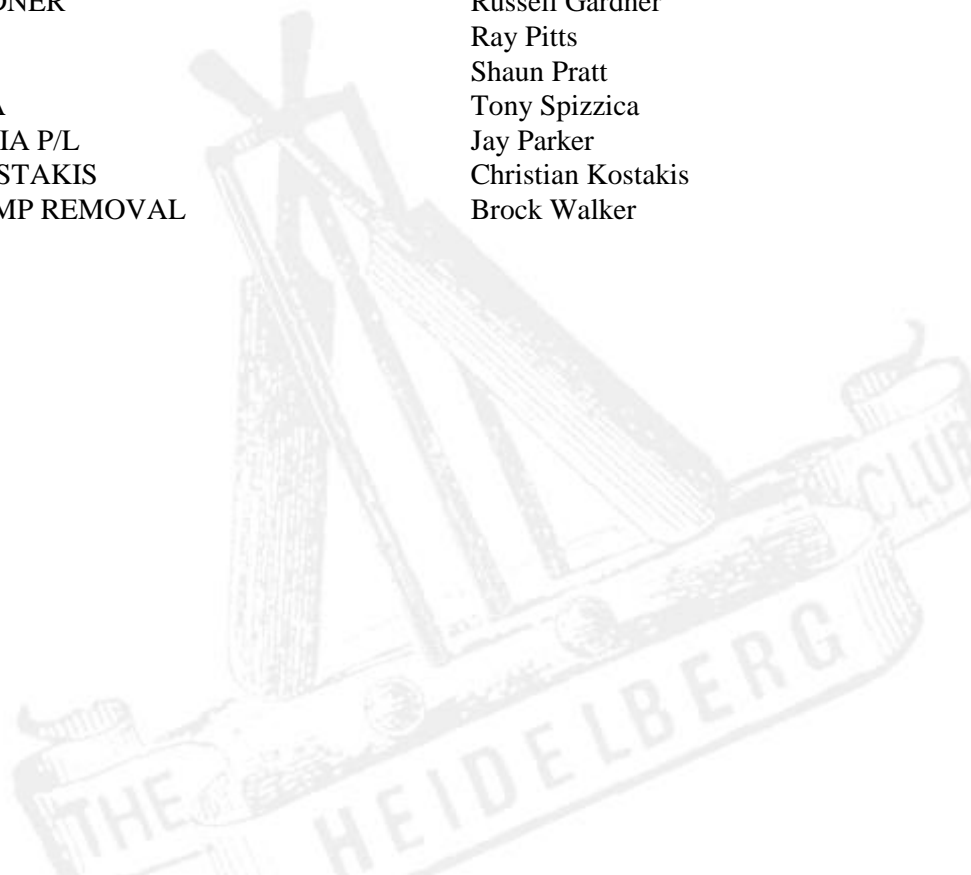

The season of 2020/2021 proved to be the most unusual of years.

The season finally got underway in mid-November 2020 after a winter of COVID-19 impacted community sport that saw the unprecedented cancellation of the entire football season.

It was quite an odd feeling walking back into the club in the week prior to the season commencing with zero football being played at all.

In light of the winter disruptions and the shortened season, the DVCA decided to abandon the two-day cricket format and play every round as a one-day game.

This took some adjusting for our playing group which I'm sure Justin will touch on in his report. For the first time in many years we were unable to secure a finals spot in any of our senior grades. Our First and Third X1's finished fifth and our second X1 finished towards the tail of the ladder losing quite a few games by the barest of margins.

Our junior program continued to flourish with the further addition of teams and continued popularity in this section. Our philosophy remains the same with our junior program – we are not interested in being the biggest club it is being the best junior club that matters most and that means directing our focus towards the development of each individual as players and people.

The one-day format in each grade proved to a bonus for the club off the field with players from each X1 returning to the social club at the end of the day's play at around the same time to enjoy the company of teammates and friends.

The winter of lockdown and hospitality restrictions saw the club use some ingenuity and utilise the terrace space on the south-east side of the building and turn it into an outdoor eating space which proved a huge success.

Another major success was the engagement of Sam Stapleton to takeover and run our food operations and his introduction and contribution could not have been better or more timely.

Overall, despite a shortened season by some seven weeks, the club reported an incredible trading result thanks to the generous and ongoing support of all our sponsors, an increase in bar sales and an increase in membership.

The club remains in an extremely healthy financial position, thanks to the diligence of control of Treasurer John Gilham, who in that role, has continued to manage year on year growth and substantial trading profit.

Firstly, to our on-field leaders and managers. Captain/Coach Justin Whitcher - another outstanding job managing the full playing group and looking after the development and growth of our First X1 on a Saturday. Gav Watson was a huge asset to the group after moving over an hour away his third-grade presence was noticeable with the bat. And in relation to the ball, we had Hayden Woodhouse take out a competition bowling award for the grade which topped off their year.

This coming season sees the inclusion of a fourth-grade team where we will be blooming more future talent which is very exciting. From a results perspective, this was a little bit of a mixed bag. We had finals representation at under 18s, 14s, and 12s level. Unfortunately, none were able to experience the ultimate success like we'd seen in previous seasons, but an invaluable experience nonetheless. Participation and enjoyment is certainly the most important thing at junior level, but taking part at the pointy end of the season is just as valuable. Finals are where kids can test themselves, compete as a team for one sole purpose, and hopefully create memories that last forever. Premierships bond people in ways that are subtle and difficult to explain, but it's subconsciously always present. I hope all our juniors can be a part of that during their time at Heidelberg.

The last point I'd like to make is on the social front. We had the addition of a revamped terrace this season which honestly changed the dynamic of the club. To see junior families enjoy meals on a Thursday night, attend various social events, as well as a joint presentation night epitomised what we've been trying to achieve for years.
